Patient Instructions after Simple Extraction and/or Surgical Extraction

Place a cold towel or an ice bag on your face for the first 6-8 hours. Apply for 15 minutes, and then remove for 15 minutes.

If medication has been prescribed, TAKE AS DIRECTED.

Apply cold towel or ice bags for 15 minutes or as needed.

Keep fingers and tongue away from the socket.

Do not rinse your mouth until the following day.

In the morning following surgery, rinse the mouth with warm salt water (½ teaspoon salt warm water glass) several times daily.

Following dental surgery it is normal to experience some discomfort such as:

- Bleeding- Normal for saliva to be slightly streaked with blood for 1-2 days.
- Swelling & stiffness- It is normal and should not cause alarm
- Diet- a liquid or soft diet is advised during the first 24 hours

Drink lots of fluids.

NO DRINKING HOT OR COLD BEVERAGES/FOOD
NO DRINKING THROUGH A STRAW
NO CARBONATED DRINKS OR SOUR DRINKS
NO SMOKING, DO NOT SPIT
NO DRINKING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
NO HEAVY LIFTING OR HEAVY WORKING
